#### Dear Parents/Carers

Last week was UK Parliament Week, and we started the week with an assembly about how the UK Parliament works and why demoncracy is so important in our society. The children then prepared speeches for our own School Parliament Elections, with each class carrying out a vote, after hearing from each of the candidates. Every child who delivered a speech should feel really proud, with some high quality speeches across the school. Those that were elected, have already met as the newly formed School Parliament this week.

On Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> November, we celebrated Be Bright Be Seen Day in KS1, with many children (and staff) coming to school in high visibility jackets, and learning about the importance of road safety. We have also had our Year 5 children learning how to cycle on the roads safely through their Bikeability course. The listening, concentration and application of important safety messages has been exemplary, and Year 5 have enjoyed the opportunity immensely. Road safety is something we take seriously at Rush Common and I am continuing to work with Oxfordshire County Council on initiatives to ensure children and families are as safe as possible when travelling to and from school. We now have a Travel Plan on our website, which is accredited as 'Good' by Modeshift Stars.

As a school community we are excellent at raising money for the school through the wide array of events organised by FoRC throughout the year. However, we sometimes have requests on how parents or the wider community can donate in other ways to the school. We have devised one simple, effective mechanism to do this, which is to visit goodhub.com. The easiest way to get to our page is to hover the camera (on your phone) over the QR code at the bottom of this page. This will take you straight to our page, which will allow you to make a one off or regular payment. These sorts of donations are vital for us to continue providing high quality education. On Monday and Tuesday this week Year 3 had an incredible time as they embarked on a journey down the Nile to visit the Great Pyramids! Each class spent the day learning everything and anything about Ancient Egypt from a highly enthusiastic and knowledgeable educator from the History Squad. The children gained so much knowledge and understanding of the time period in this exciting and hands-on approach to learning – an unforgettable experience!

Today our choir are very excited to join a number of other schools from across Oxfordshire for the 'Big Sing'. This is a unique opportunity to sing in a massed choir, led by a highly experienced conductor. The experience will be truly fantastic, and I hope all the parents that are able to attend, enjoy watching their children perform.



#### Christmas All Yours Period Boxes

We know that Christmas can be an expensive and tricky time for a lot of families, and we are here to support anyone who needs period products, either for themselves or their family members. As this is a very busy time of year for us, we would suggest you order your period box sooner rather than later so that we can ensure that it is with you before the Christmas holidays. The last date for requesting a period box in time for Christmas is <a href="https://doi.org/10.1016/j.chr.nd/">Thursday 12th December</a>. Any request made after this date may not arrive before the holidays.

All requests are free and confidential, and you can request your All Yours box here: https://www.allyoursbox.co.uk/request

All our boxes are prepared by volunteers and most boxes are delivered by volunteers. Where we are not able to hand deliver a box, we use 2<sup>nd</sup> class Royal Mail to send our boxes. We ask that you allow at least 21 days for delivery, but we do aim to drop off boxes far quicker than this.

#### Christmas All Yours Collection Points

All Yours will be taking a break from 21<sup>st</sup> December until 2<sup>nd</sup> January. Any requests we receive during this time will be processed when we return on 3<sup>nd</sup> January. If you find you need period products urgently during this time you can collect a period box from our various collection points. You can find a list of our collection points on our website, but we would suggest checking opening times with the venue before travelling as they may vary over the festive period.
