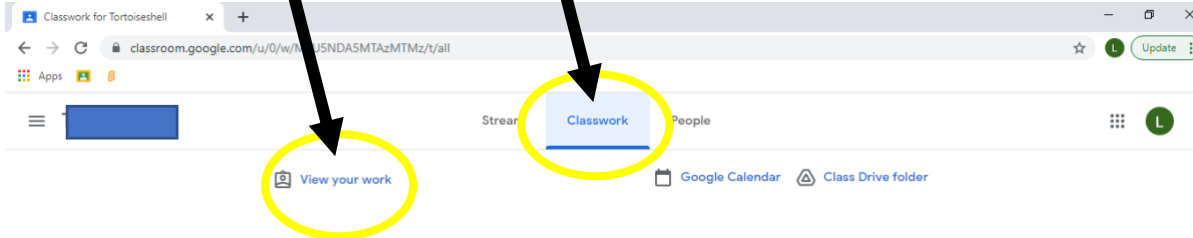


How to view your work and feedback in Google Classroom

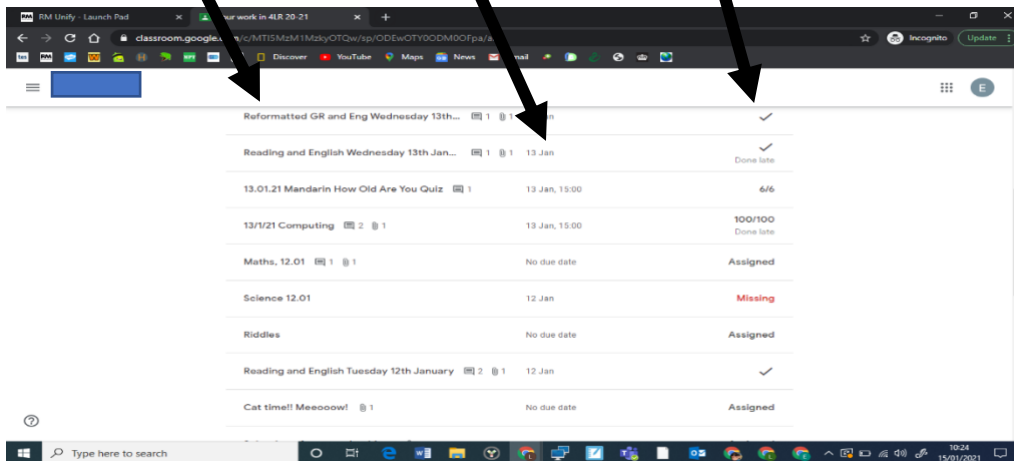
In Google Classroom, you are able to view all of your work.

- 1) Go to the 'Classwork' tab at the top of your browser. On an iPad, it's at the bottom.
- 2) Choose 'View your work'



Once inside the 'View your work' page, you will see a list of all of your work by:

title (left column), due date (central column) and status (right column).



How to view your work and feedback in Google Classroom

On the right, there are several types of status:

Assigned – this means the work hasn't been completed yet.

Missing – this means the work hasn't been turned in by the due date.

Handed in – this means the work has been turned in to the teacher.


Score – this means the teacher has looked at the work and given it a score.

✓ (tick) – this means the teacher has checked the work.

Next to the assignment titles, there may be a speech bubble.

This means there is a comment on the work.

It will be a private comment providing feedback.
