Remote Learning Expectations

This letter is to share our approach to remote learning if your child needs to isolate due to Covid-19. Work will only be set for children who have tested positive (and are not unwell) or when parents have kept their child at home to wait for a PCR test result. If your child is unwell, there is no expectation that they will have to complete the work set.

Our staff team are very committed to providing the best opportunities to all of our pupils. We ask for your patience and understanding when work is set as teachers will still be in school teaching all day. Should your child be isolating at home and their teacher is still in school with the class, work will be provided and feedback will be given in a manageable way; teachers will not be available during teaching time.

Please ensure that your child is able to log into Google Classroom to access the work provided for them.

Whilst work will be provided, we understand that families may not be able to complete all work due to individual circumstances. We do not want to add any undue pressure to any of our families.

As always, we greatly appreciate your understanding and support of the school. It is through continuing to work together that we will achieve great outcomes for our pupils and maintain a strong school community.
